





he existing home was a tiny weatherboard home and there were main power lines running across the block.

Renovating and extending the original dwelling was simply not an option. The only solution was to knock down the existing home and design and build something new, exciting and modern.

In today's property market, quite often the best piece of real estate is the one where you live. Over the past few years property prices have risen dramatically pushing them up to levels that people never thought possible. This can often mean that older properties have a higher overall land value, with the house itself being of very little worth in the total property equation. Due to this, many home owners are now choosing to demolish their existing house and build a new one in its place. This proves to be very economical and raises the value of the property considerably, with the added benefit of being able to tailor make a home to suit the block and their lifestyle.

"Amber" our latest display home is influenced by the architecture and vernacular philosophy of Frank Lloyd Wright. Wright evolved a new concept of interior space in architecture, rejecting the existing view of rooms as "single function" boxes. Wright created overlapping and interpenetrating rooms with shared spaces. He created the idea of "defined" space as opposed to enclosed space. He put much emphasis on simple geometry and horizontal lines. He was

also well known for this mastery of the internal environment, with great attention paid to lighting, heating and climate control.

"Amber" mimics all those principals. Situated on a medium sized block, this double storey home encapsulates the essence of modern living.

Low slung, colourbond, hip-roofs, are offset by a blend of façade materials. A tiled charcoal coloured blade wall creates a strong focal point from the streetscape. Large precious pearl thermal break, double glazed windows seamlessly integrate the inside and outside. While the wide eaves protect the home from the outside elements.

The design of this home is simple, elegant and timeless. We have put a lot of thought into the room sizes and their relationship to one another. We believe that we have maximised the space while allowing the full potential of the home to be noticed and utilized. Initially BBS designed this home for a young busy business couple with a young family. Due to a change in their circumstances, the clients could not go ahead with their project. We therefore asked if we could buy the block of land from them so we could build a display home. We thought that the design that was developed for the original client represented what a young, busy family wanted from their sanctuary. We only made some minor amendments and fine tuned the original plans.

We have noticed that over the last few years more and more people are opting to live in an apartment style accommodation mainly due to the fact that they do not want to, nor do they have the time, to look after and maintain large gardens. Whilst "Amber" is a stand alone home, the gardens have been designed by a professional landscaper to keep in mind that this home has been designed for professionals, business people and retirees. The beautiful

gardens require virtually no maintenance yet they provide a perfect private oasis that can be enjoyed throughout the year. There is even a plunge pool, with the most beautiful shimmering blue tiles, for those scorching summer days.

A 2200 litre water tank that collects all the roof water has been installed. The tank feeds the toilets and the washing machine in the home. It can also be used to water the gardens.

Isabella, the co-owner of BBS, grew up in Poland in an apartment block. She really struggles to understand why people that have the freedom to live anywhere would opt to live in an apartment block when you can have apartment style living with the benefit of having your own privacy, own a pet, feel nature all around you, not listen to your neighbours that live behind the wall and not have your neighbours listen to your conversations as you sit outside and talk with your friends.

The home has been designed to take advantage of the northerly aspect. All living areas and a couple of the bedrooms face north maximizing daylight hours and the solar penetration into the home. This combined with R2 wall and R4 ceiling insulation and anticon insulation under the roof, as well as sarking on all the external walls and double glazed windows means the home is very energy efficient and environmentally friendly. It leaves a low carbon emissions footprint on our precious environment.

The home has been installed with a back to base security system as well as security cameras just to give the occupants real peace of mind.

The master bedroom is located on the upper level of the home boasting loads of space. It is a very soft, romantic, sensual room. A bedroom is so much more than a place for sleeping. Bedroom designs reflect the personalities of their occupants, their styles as well as their passions.


